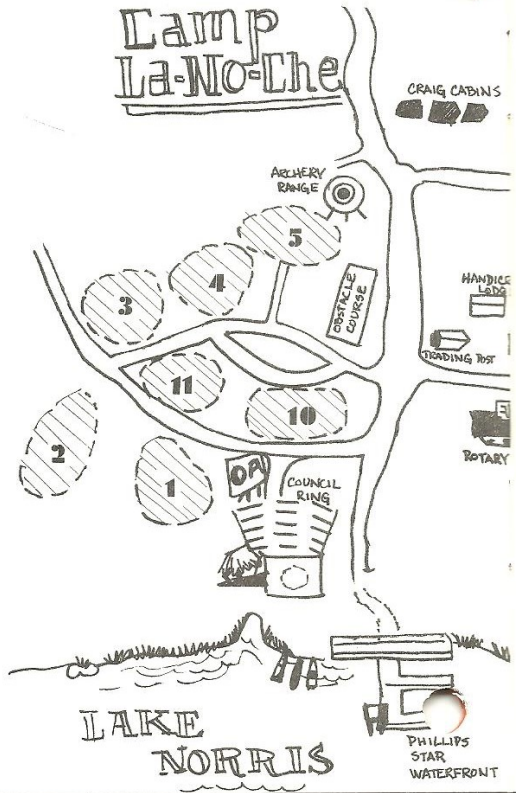

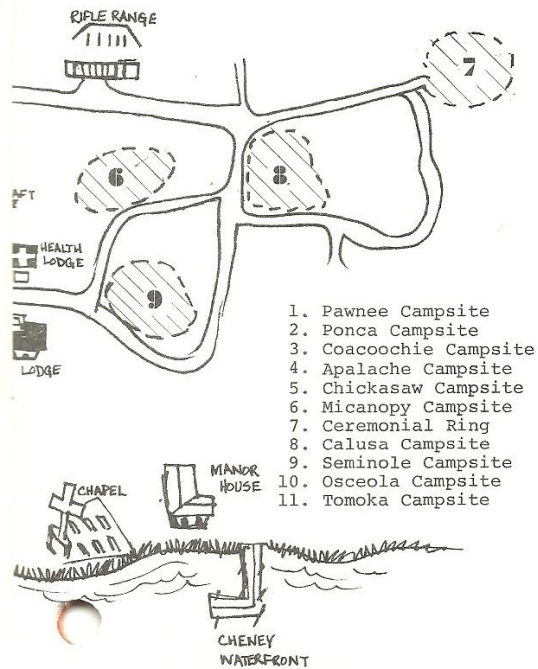

Quest

Festival of Feathers

The Festival of Feathers is the Indian Lore competition between lodges. It will be held on Saturday Evening at the Council Ring. The following guidelines will be used:

DRUM/SINGING

1. One drum group per lodge
2. Group provides own drum & sticks
3. Drummers must be under 21
4. 3 songs for each drum will be sung including description

DANCE COMPETITION

1. All contestants must be under 21
2. Novice:
 - a. Danced particular style 1 year or less
 - b. Never won any awards for the particular style
3. Pro:
 - a. Danced particular style more than 1 year

b. Won awards for particular style of dancing

4. Contests:
 - a. Old time (novice & pro)
 - b. Modern Fancy "Feather" (novice & pro)
 - c. Straight Dance (one category)

SKILL SOLO

1. Sign up with Sat. program M.C.
2. Demonstrates skill beyond that of normal dancer
3. Must make arrangements for own music
4. Skill Solo is not judged for quest or best section dance team

Display of craft articles will be at 11:00-1:00 Saturday. Judging will take place at 1:00. All those with entries are asked to be present to answer questions.
