## CONFERENCE TRAINING

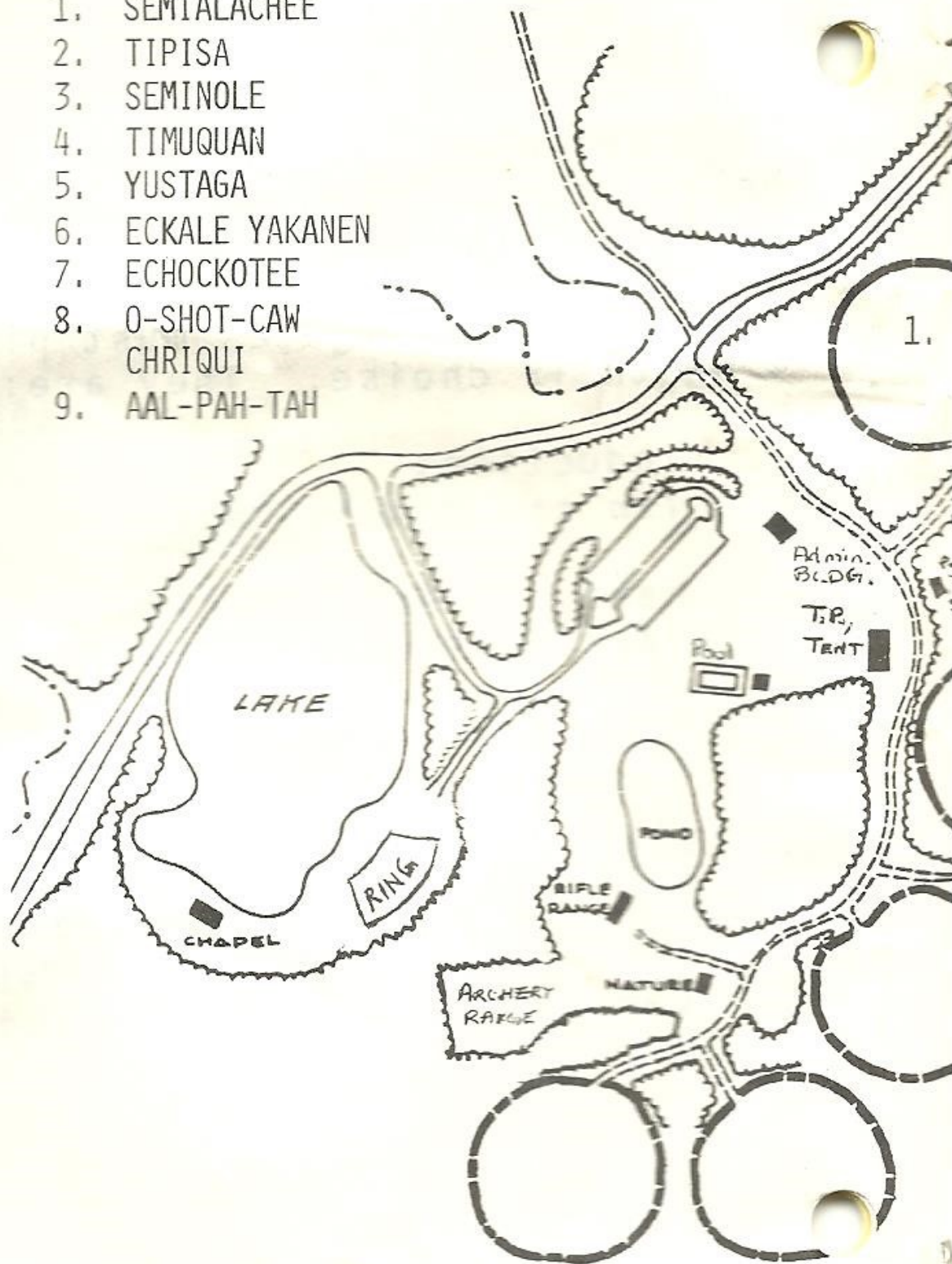

*(In front of the Camp and Conference Trading Posts)*

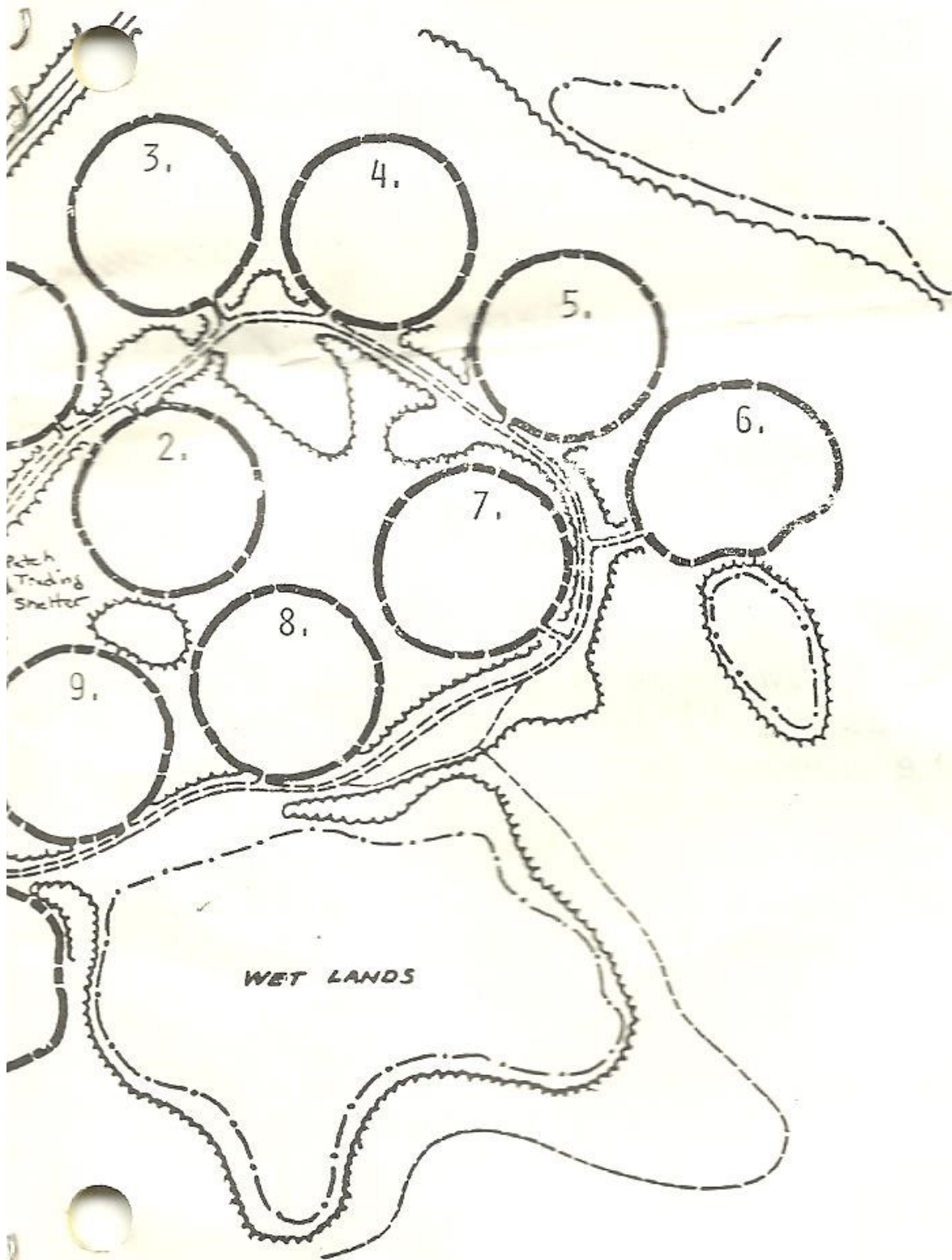
