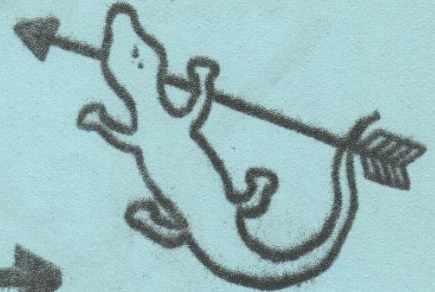
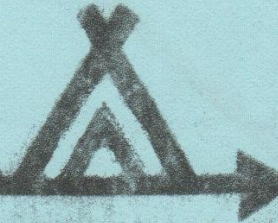
Meeting 10:30
