# FESTIVAL OF FEATHERS

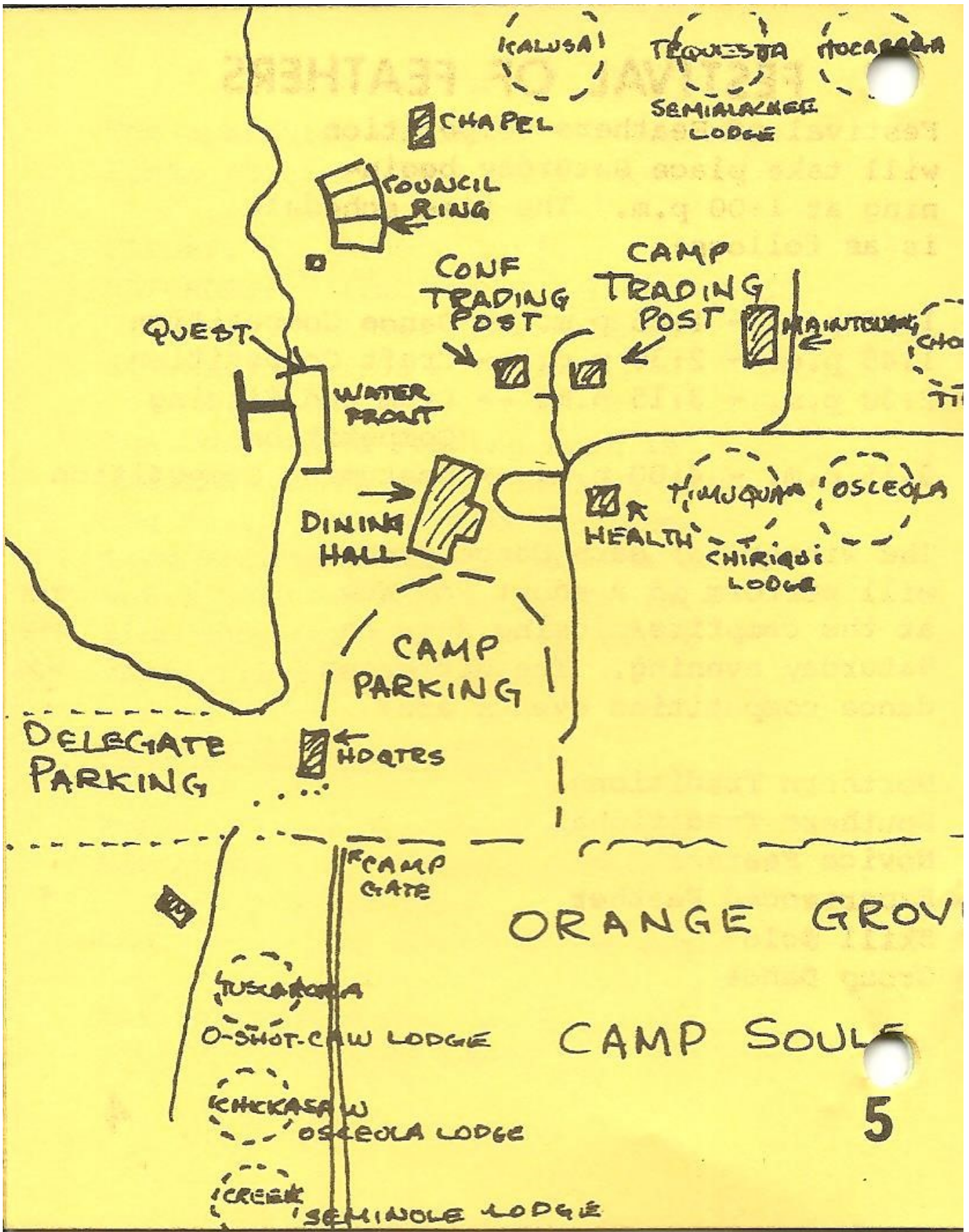
Festival of Feathers competition will take place Saturday beginning at 1:00 p.m. The time schedule is as follows:
