You will notice some changes in this years seminar, changes that will make the program a little more enjoyable.



### ➤ How to Form a Group Dance Team

How to form a team, selecting dances, selecting costumes, teamwork & competition.

### ☐ Advanced Ceremonies

Same as CEREMONIES but on the Brotherhood. Open to Brotherhood & Vigil members only.

### ➤ Promotion, Publicize & Programming

How to properly promote an event, publicize it, through newsletters, to program the event for fun, fellowship and service.

### ☐ Drum & Singing

Customs, traditions of the drum, learn songs & prepare for competition.

### ➤ Southern Feather Dancing

Individual costume parts and the reason for them. How to develop a quality costume. Color schemes and movement. Dancing and what the judges look for.

### ☐ Traditional Dancing

History and background for straight and old time. Others will be the same as Southern Feather but pertaining to Traditional.

### ➤ Camp Promotions

Publicizing summer camp, importance of year round camping, National Camping Award, Where to go Camping.

### ☐ Florida Indians


