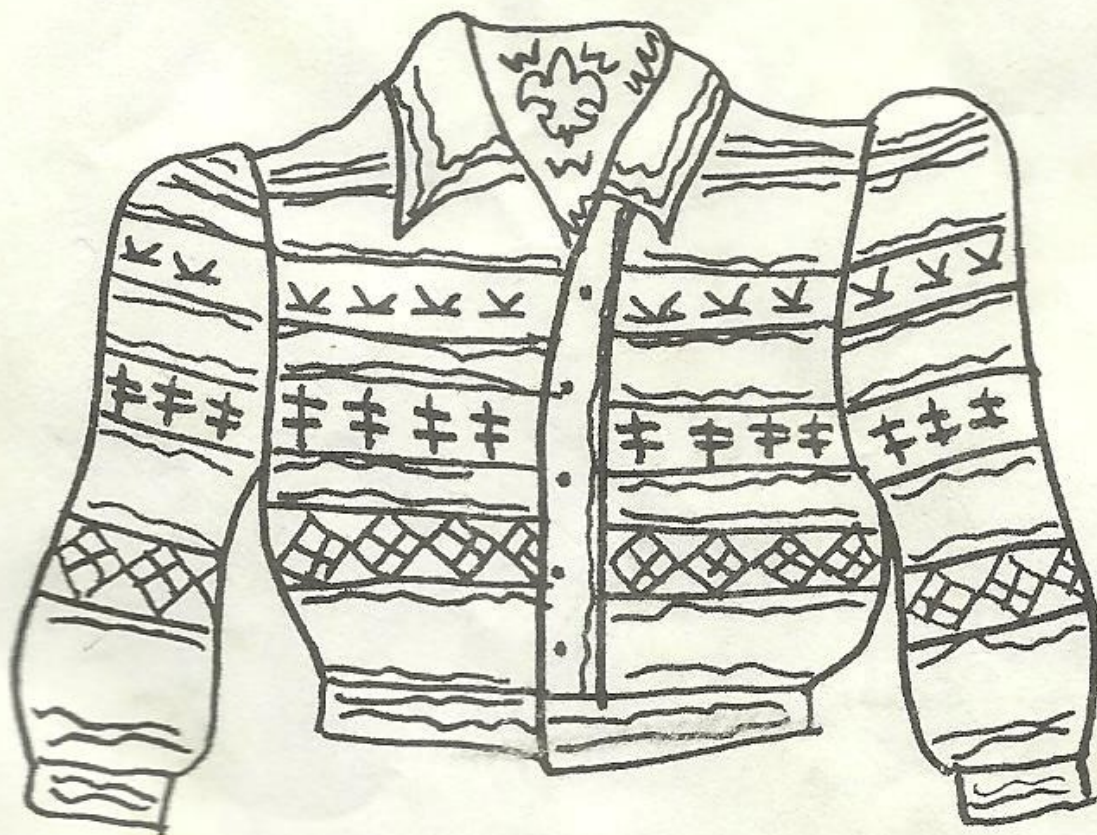

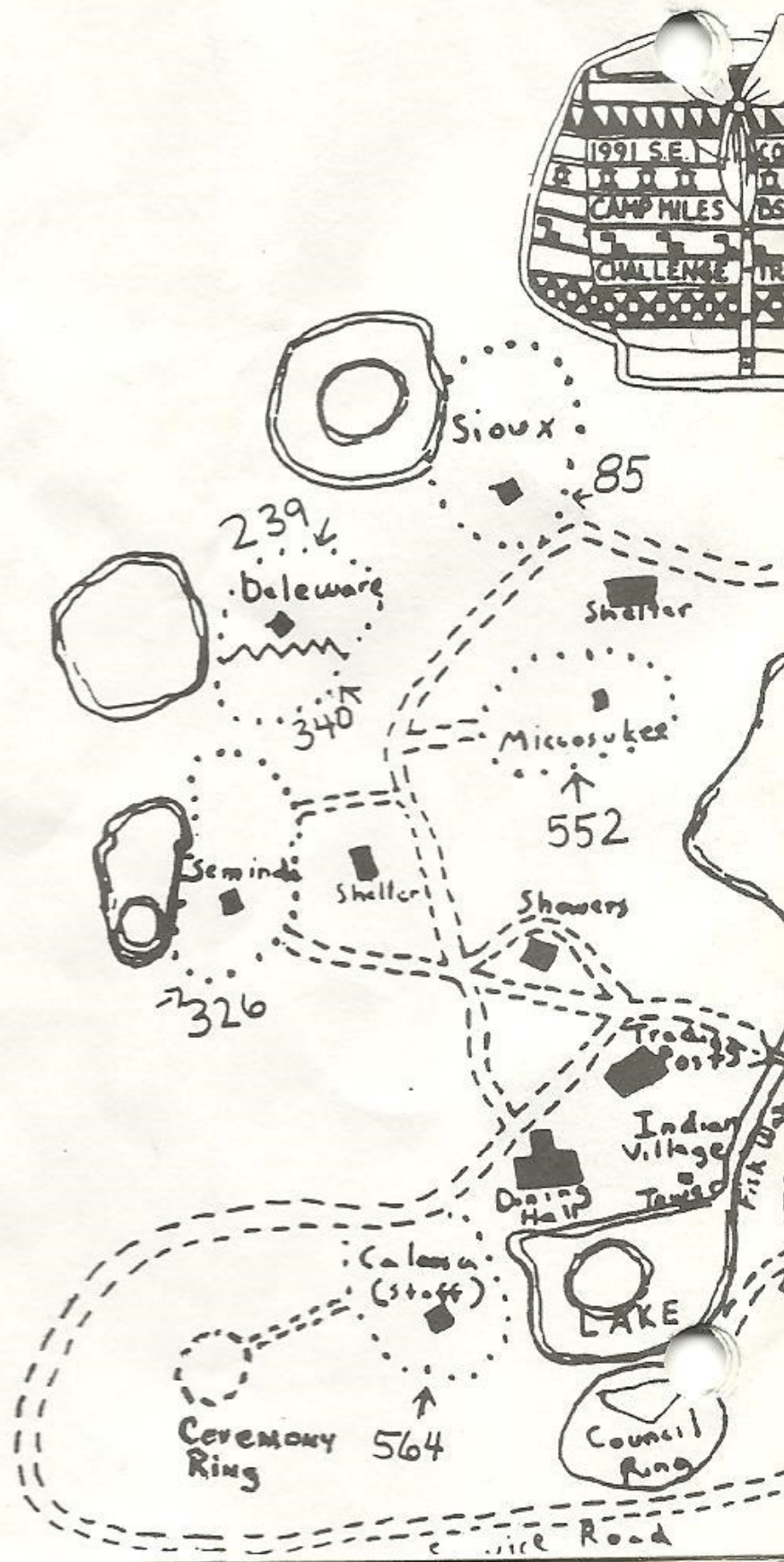

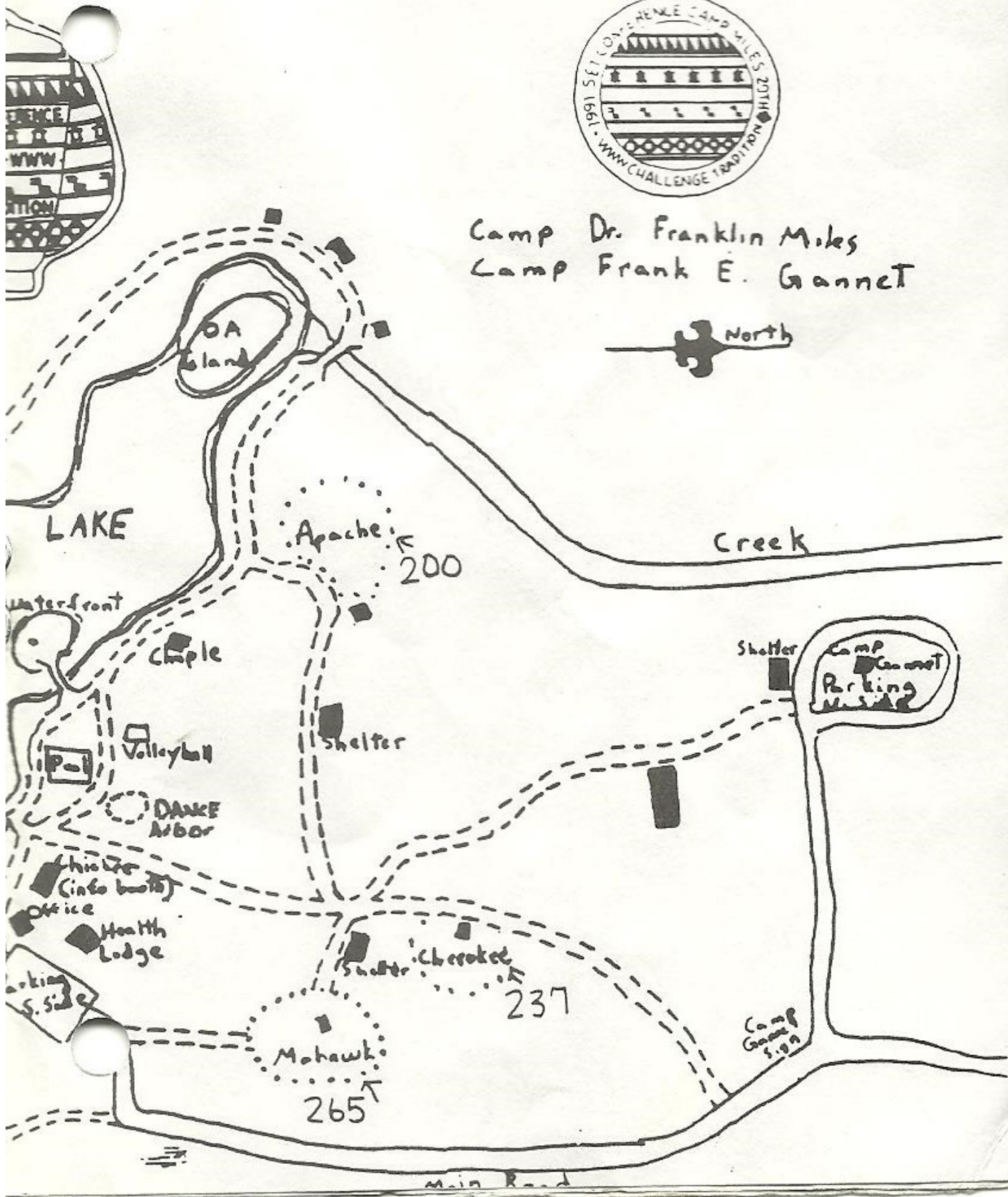

### Quest Events

**Aqua Nerdling**--5 Arrowmen jump in the pool holding onto a oar. Without releasing the oar, they must swimm one length of the pool, round a marker, and return to starting point. Letting go of oar is a 10 second penalty.

**Triathalon**--3 Arrowmen. Swimmer begins race in pool and passes baton to runner who will run crosscountry to the canoe.

**OA Brainbowl**--3 Arrowmen will battle it out in a quizbowl game on facts from the Manual for the Ordeal, the OA Handbook, Boy Scout Handbook, and the Patrol Leader's Handbook. Chickee.

**Lodge Challenge**--3 Arrowmen are issued a bowsaw and 2 lengths of rope. They must saw a stake placed in the center of a 10 foot circle without entering circle. Health Lodge.

**Friction Bridge**--6 Arrowmen must build a bridge over a creek without using rope. Chapel.

**Tug of War**--Will be done in 2 groups. Held as a double elimination with finals being single elimination. Each lodge may have two teams of 10 Arrowmen each. One team must weight less then 1000 pounds. No limit on other team. Losing team may get wet and messy. Bridge.

**Adult Sink-A-Thon** will be held in the Fisk Waterway at 4:30 Saturday. Lodge Advisor and Staff Advisors will participate.
