

YOUTH PROTECTION STATEMENT

All Conference participants are reminded to strictly adhere to the B.S.A. Policy and Guidelines for Youth Protection. Two deep leadership should be maintained at all times when working with Youth members under the age of 18. In the Order of the Arrow, members under 21 (18-21) are considered youth members, however, only with regard to program and leadership. In order to provide consistent youth-adult separation, we require that the 18-21 age group maintain separate sleeping arrangements from those 21 and over.
