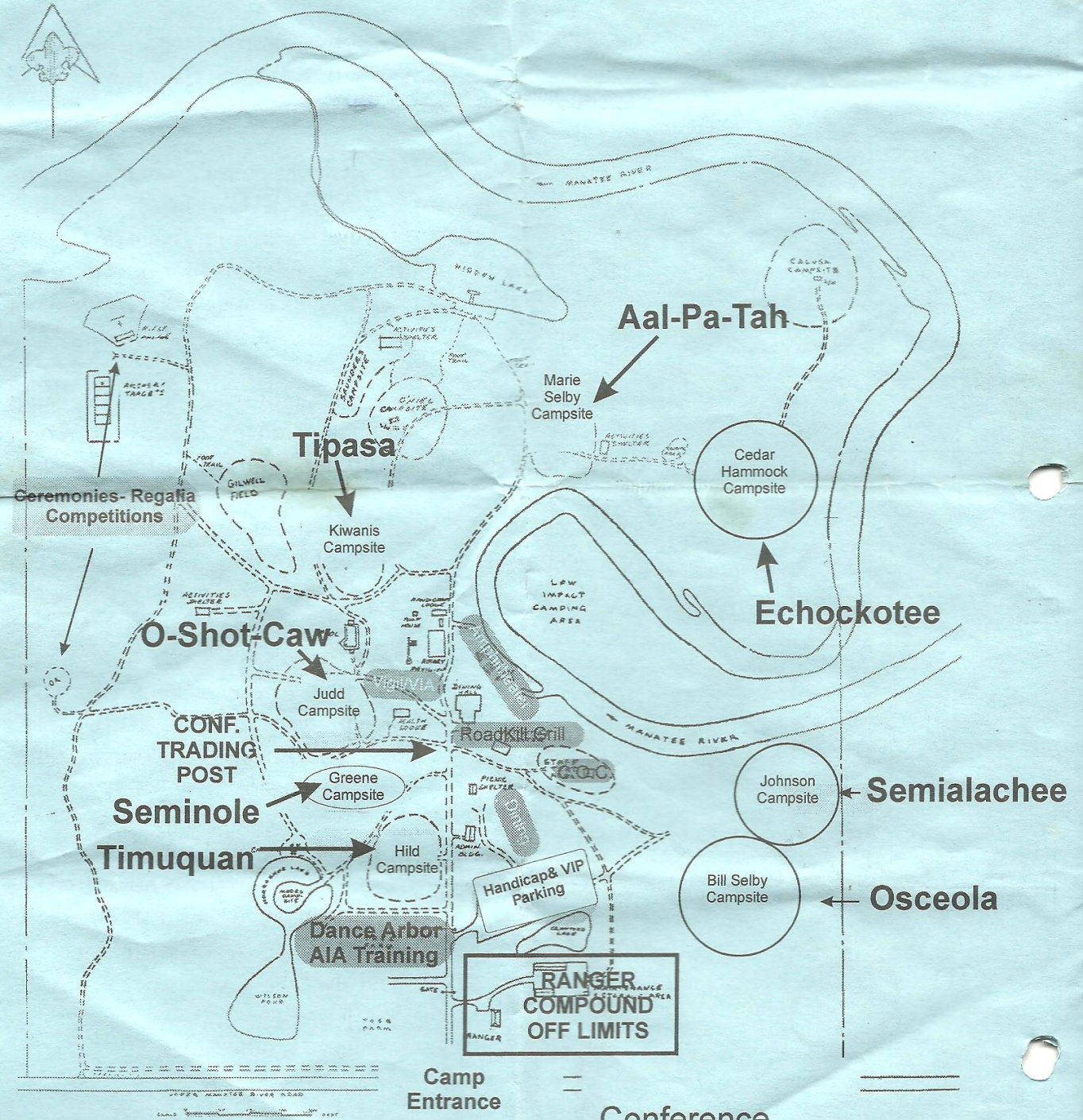
We've got a lot planned for you and your lodge, and we hope that we can extend to all our brothers the spirit that "A Cheerful Heart is Lively"!
