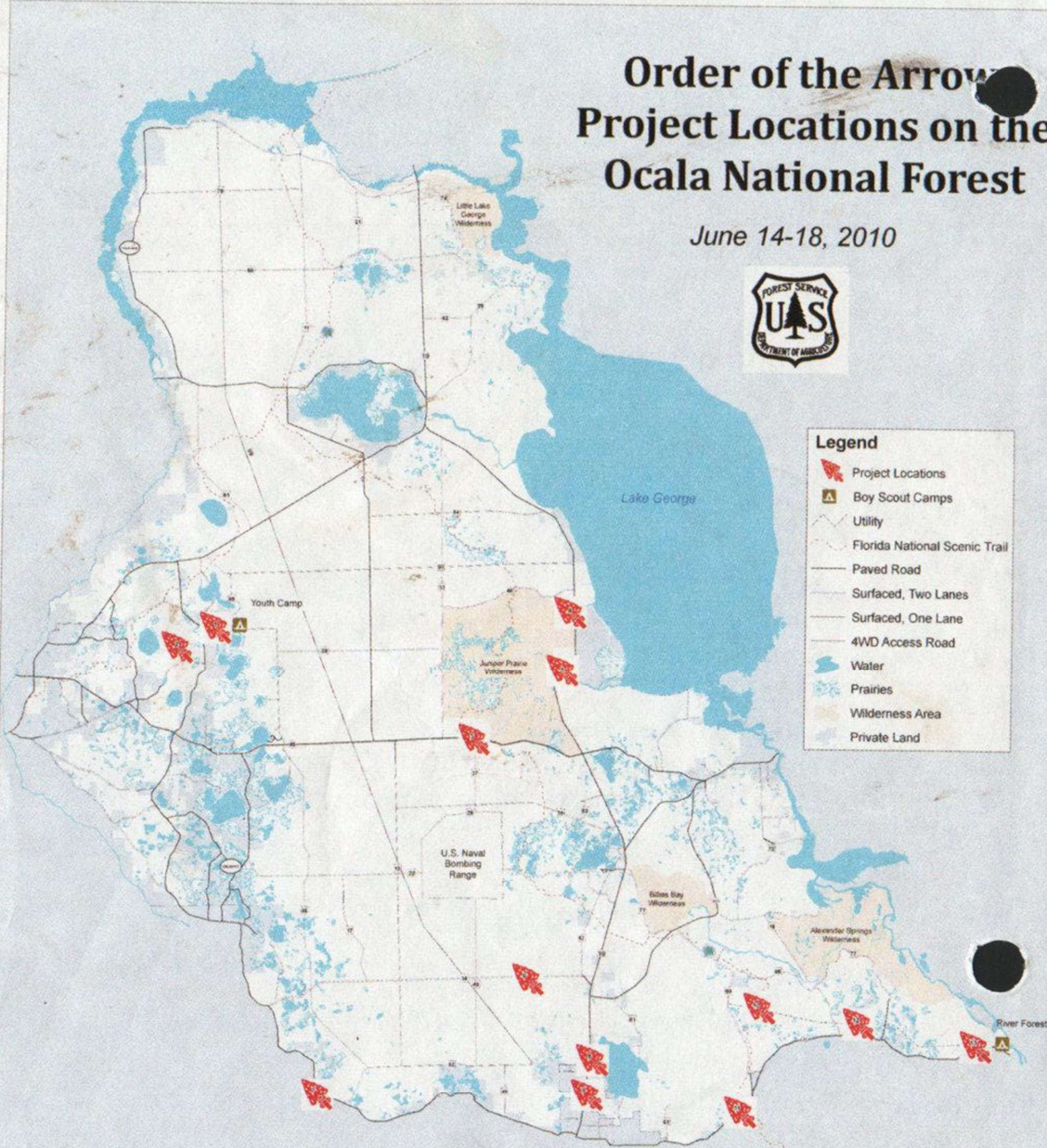
# Order of the Arrow Project Locations on the Ocala National Forest

June 14-18, 2010

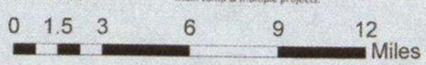
