## The Grill

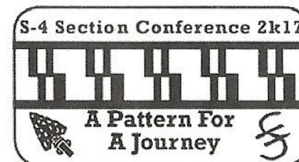

- Tug-o-war

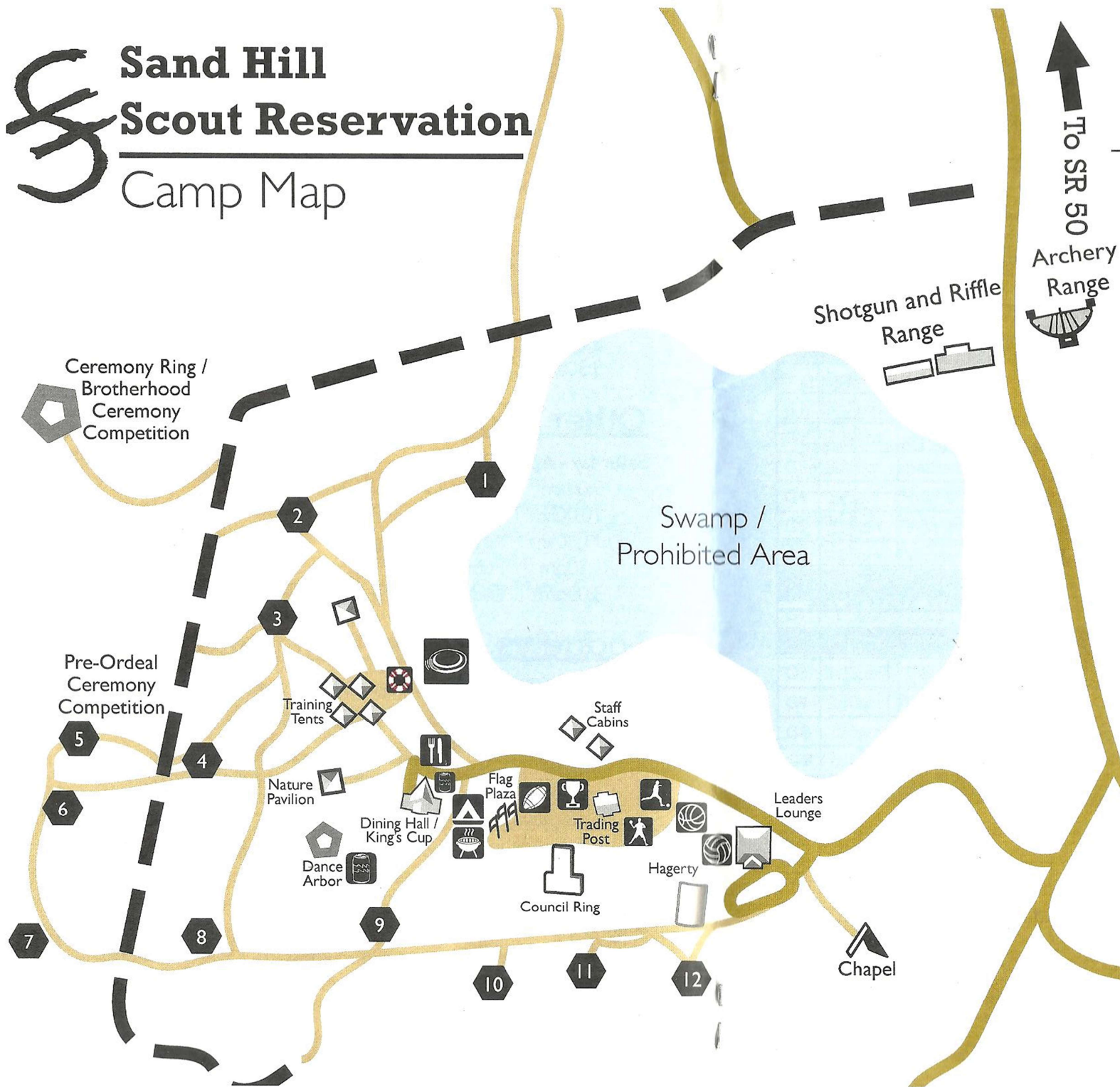
There are also some adult-orientated competitions as well. These adult competitions include:
